

COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE

Understand how to listen carefully and why listening is important

Engage with story times

Listen attentively and respond to what they hear with relevant questions, comments and actions when being read to and during whole class and small group interactions

Ask questions to find out more and to check they understand what has been said to them, clarifying understanding

Develop social phrases

Engage in story times

Hold conversations when engaged in back and forth exchange with their teacher and peers

Learn new vocabulary

Use new vocabulary through the day

PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

See themselves as a valuable individual

Build constructive and respectful relationships

Express and discuss their feelings and consider the feelings of others, regulate behavior accordingly

Work and play co-operatively and take turns with others

Give focused attentions to what the teacher says

Maintain and develop positive relationships with peers and staff

Continue to encourage back and forth conversations between one another

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

Further develop the skills they need to manage the school day successfully: routines, mealtimes, lining up, personal care

Develop fine motor skills - holding pencil correctly, using scissors etc.

Revise and refine the fundamental movement skills they have already acquired - rolling, crawling, walking, jumping, running, hopping, skipping and climbing

LITERACY

Read individual letters by saying sounds for them

Demonstrate understanding of what has been read to them by retelling stories and narratives using their own words and recently introduced vocabulary

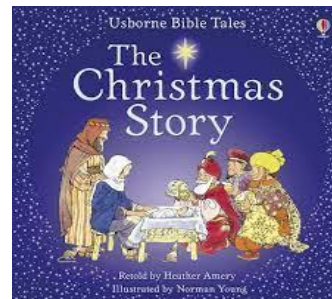
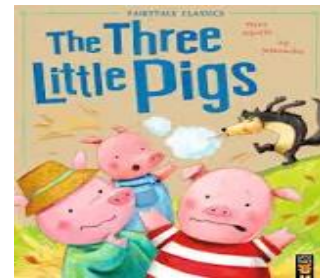
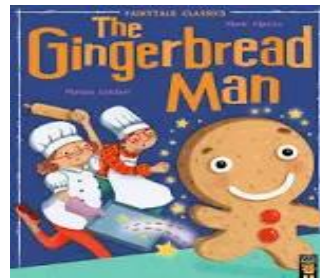
Anticipate key events in stories

Count objects, actions and sounds / (1:1) correspondence
Subitise

Link the number (numeral) with its cardinal number value

Compare numbers

Continue, copy and create repeating patterns

Compare length, weight and capacity

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

Talk about members of their immediate family and community

Name and describe people who are familiar to them

Talk about the lives of people around them and their roles in society

Know some similarities and differences between past and present

Explore the natural world around them, making observations - describe their immediate environment

Understand the important processes and changes in the natural world around them, including seasons and changing states of matter

Recognise that people have different beliefs and celebrate different times in different ways

Recognise some similarities and difference between life in this country and life in other countries

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

Develop storylines in their play

Sing a range of well know nursery rhymes and songs
Sing in a group or on their own, increasingly matching the pitch and following the melody

Safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with colour, design, texture, form and function
