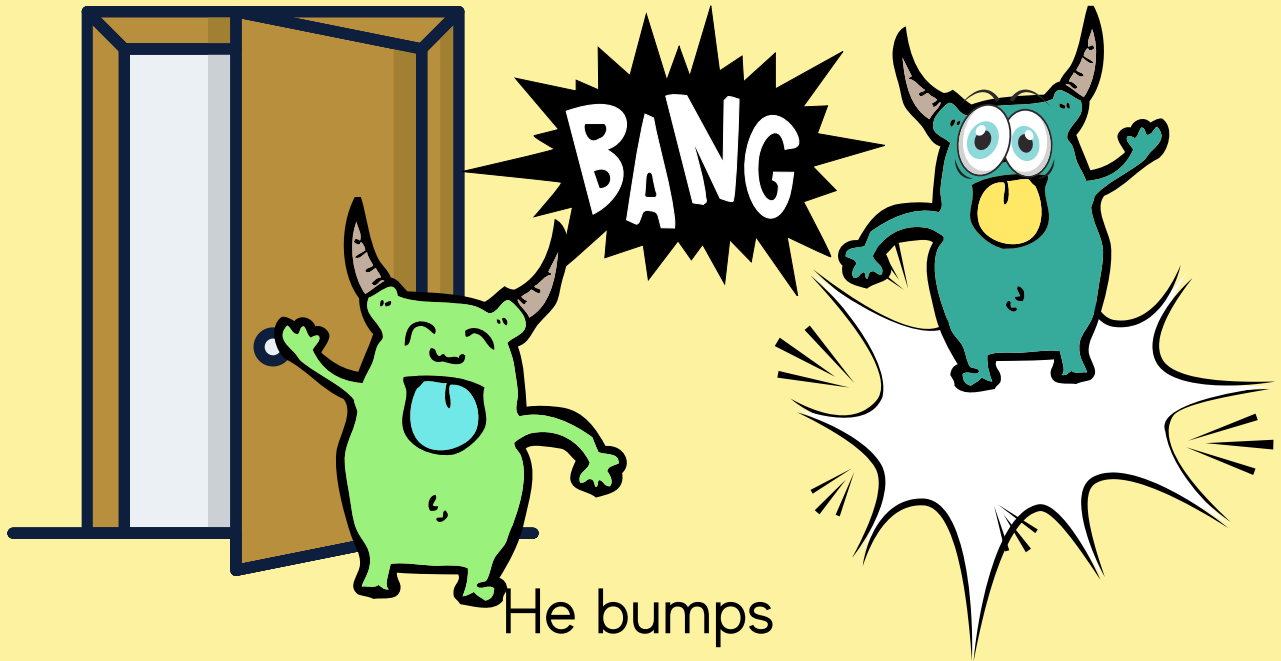

A goblin lives in our house all the year round.



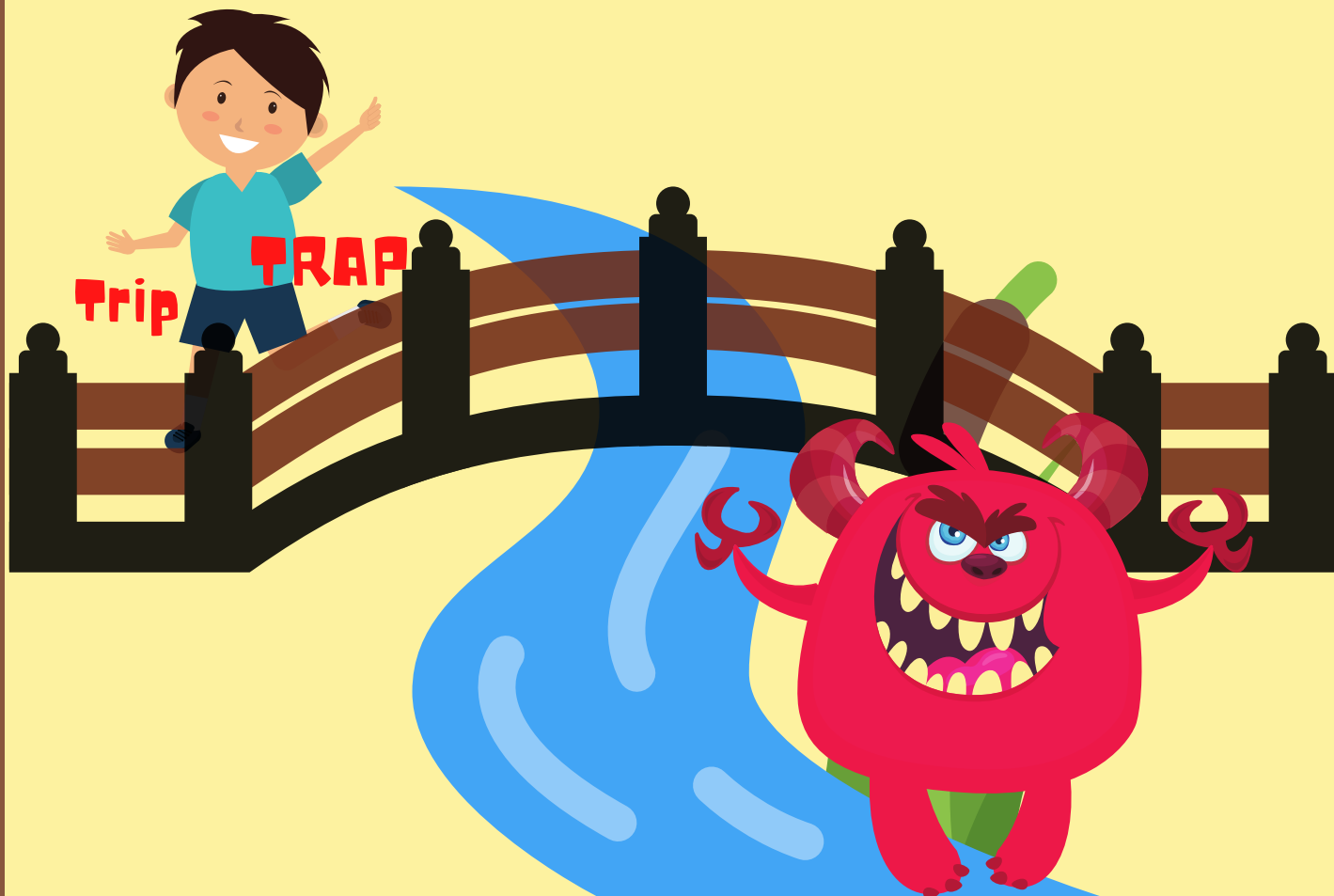
He bumps

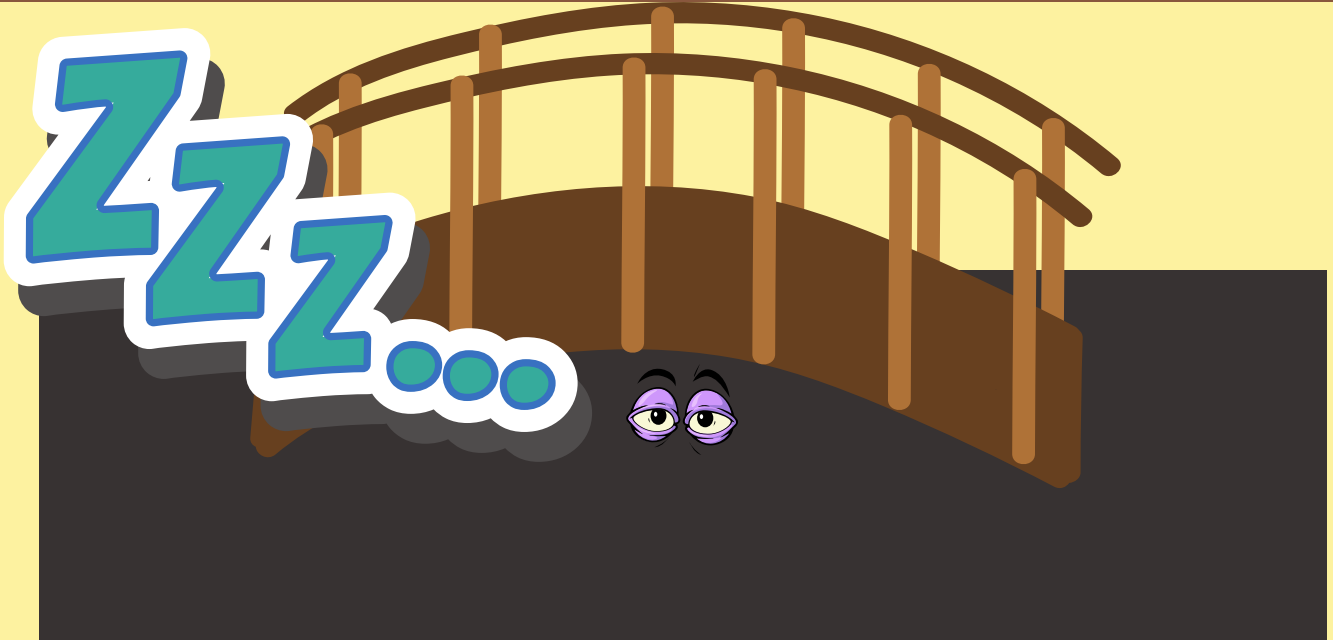
