Admissions Policy

Cheshire West and Chester Council policy ensures that all children living within a catchment area can be offered a place at a school near their home. The CW&C Council will contact parents during the Autumn term, the year prior to admission, giving full details of the admission procedure and the dates by which parents need to inform the CW&C Council of their choice of school. As your local small school we welcome all local children to become part of 'Our School Family'. If however, we have not reached our admission limit, parents from outside catchment can express a preference for our school, and if this preferred school is below the admission limit for the relevant age group, a place will be offered.

The school currently has an admission limit of 15 pupils per year group.

If our school is over subscribed, the priorities for admission are on the following bases:

Children in Cheshire Care

Children resident within the Aston by Sutton Primary School catchment zone.

Children with older brothers or sisters in the school.

Children living nearest the school.

Admission induction arrangements

Every effort is made to ensure that children settle quickly and happily into school. Intakes to Reception are staggered initially, enabling staff to give children more attention during their first weeks. Before starting school, all children will have had a preliminary visit. A settling in period is planned for the first few weeks of term beginning with half days and then gradually lengthening the school day until children are happy to stay for a full day.
