PARENTS' SAFER PARKING CHARTER

The Junior Safety Officers and pupils at Aston by Sutton Primary school have constructed a Safe Parking Charter. They want everyone who drives to the School to sign up to the following Parking Charter to help keep everyone safe and improve the quality of life for all those within the school environment. Please remember Road Safety is everyone's responsibility.

I hereby agree to abide by the guidelines outlined within the Safe Parking Charter. By signing up to this charter you agree to:

- Drive safely Be polite and park with a reasonable gap between you and other people's cars – Think about other people.
- No Turning Turning on the road is dangerous and holds up the traffic
- Zig-Zags Please no stopping on yellow zigzag lines that are outside of schools, to keep us safe and to not get a fine and licence points.
- Driveways Please don't park in front of our neighbours driveways they won't be able to get out.
- Stopping and Blocking Please don't stop in the middle of the road or the traffic will block.
- Speed Limit Don't go past the speed limit or a crash could happen. Always check your speed you never know you might get caught by a camera.

- Time keeping Please try to leave with plenty of time, you shouldn't have to rush the lane to school. If you arrive on time you can park safely.
- Parking on the kerb Save us by not parking on the pavement, instead park on the road beside. People and prams may not get past.
- Pavement side Keep your children safe by parking and letting us out on the pavement side.
- Pheasants Watch out for the pheasants be aware drive with care.

To forward any concerns regarding dangerous parking and road safety in the school environment to the Head teacher or a Governor, who can then take appropriate action.
