Dear Parents / Carers

Please be advised that there are currently Covid cases in all classes in school. None of the classes have enough cases to warrant further measures being implemented at this point, however, we would be grateful if you could be extra vigilant and follow these rules closely.

#### **What should I do if my child develops COVID-19 symptoms?**

The main symptoms of COVID-19 are:

- new continuous cough and/or
- fever (temperature of 37.8°C or higher)
- loss of or change in, normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

If your child develops any of these symptoms, you must arrange for them to have a PCR test as soon as possible. A PCR test can be arranged via the NHS UK ([www.nhs.uk](http://www.nhs.uk)) website or by contacting NHS 119 via telephone if you do not have internet access.

**Your child should self-isolate immediately and they should not attend school. If the symptoms develop at school we will call you and ask you to collect your child.**

Please contact the school by phone or email [head@aston.cheshire.sch.uk](mailto:head@aston.cheshire.sch.uk) to inform us your child has COVID-19 symptoms and you are awaiting a COVID-19 test.

#### **What should I do if someone in my household tests positive?**

If one individual in a household tests positive, any children and young people in that household who attend school or college should:

- Take a PCR test (ideally on Day 3-5 after first exposure), and
- Take a daily LFD test for 10 consecutive days from the date of first exposure
- Continue to attend school provided that their test results (PCR and LFD) are negative
- Self-isolate for 10 full days from the date of the test if any of their test results are positive
- In the event of a positive LFD test result, obtain a confirmatory PCR test
- If the confirmatory PCR test is taken within the two days following the positive LFD result and the PCR result is negative, the young person can return to school/college.
