Dear Parents / Carers

We have been informed by Public Health England that, as cases in school have reduced, we are able to invite you into school to watch the Christmas play.

A new survey is now live on School Spider for you to complete, please can you do this **by the end of the day on Monday, 6th December** so that we have time to allocate tickets and let you know which performance you can attend. Your username is your first name and surname e.g. joebloggs

We have been asked to implement the following measures to make the event as Covid secure as possible, we appreciate your cooperation with this:

- All attendees must take a Lateral Flow test on the morning they are to attend - please send a message on the Gateway App to confirm the result. We will phone anyone who hasn't confirmed by 10am as we must have this to allow entry.
- All attendees must wear a mask, unless exempt.
- If there is a positive case in your household, or if you have been informed that you are a close contact of a positive case, please do not attend.
- Please also do not attend if you have Covid symptoms or are feeling generally unwell.

There is a full dress rehearsal being held on Monday, 13th December for our Key Stage 2 children to watch.

Mrs Plant has requested that NO PHOTOGRAPHS OR VIDEOS are to be taken during the performance as some parents have requested that their child(ren) are not photographed/filmed. Thank you in advance for your co-operation. As we have only just come out of enhanced Covid measures, rather than parents staying behind to take photos of their child on the day, we will take individual photos of all of the children to share with you.

Please note, there will be no PE or after school club on Tuesday, 14th December. Children should come to school in their normal uniform.
